Clarkdale-Jerome families, please see below the frequently asked questions list below. If you have any further questions, do not hesitate to contact the school.

1) What is a walk in?

A walk in is where teachers and staff collectively walk together to the school in the morning prior to the contracted start of the day. You may see teachers and staff wearing red walking on the way to school during some mornings next week.

2) What is a walk out?

This is a pre-planned absence for staff members. Communication will occur on a regular basis as new information is given to the district that may affect the walk out.

3) How many days will the walk out last?

At this time, we are planning for a one-day walk out. We do not anticipate our faculty and staff participating in multiple days.

4) When will the walk out occur and will the district have to make up the school day?

The walk out will occur on Thursday, April 26<sup>th</sup> and we are cancelling school for that day. Our makeup day will occur on Friday, May 4<sup>th</sup>. This was a regularly scheduled teacher professional development day.

5) If school is closed, will the school year be extended?

Since we are making up the cancelled day on May 4<sup>th</sup>, we do not have to extend the school year beyond the regularly scheduled last day.

6) Will there still be field trips the day school is cancelled?

No. All school field trips will be cancelled.

7) Do I have to call my child in sick during a school closure?

You do not have to call your child in if there is a school closure

8) Are there daycare options?

The Discovery Center, operated by Buena Vista, will be able to provide daycare for a cost. Please see the letter that details how you can take advantage of this opportunity.
