Dear CJSD Families,

I am emailing you again today as I wanted to let you know that our governing board, this past Tuesday night, approved the Conceptual Frameworks for our “Return to Learn” re-opening plan for the 2020-'21 school year (see attachment). The frameworks document is an abbreviated version of what you will receive next week with our full family communication plan on re-opening our school. The frameworks includes a short version of our health and safety protocols that we will incorporate when we return to In Person learning. It also covers (in general terms) transportation, food service, scheduling and athletics. Our other learning models we described earlier are also outlined in more detail. As you can imagine, this has been a very complex process over the last month and a half since we received the guidance from the state of AZ and we are still working out some of the logistics involved.

As stated yesterday in my email, our governing board approved a new start date to school, which will be **Monday, August 10th**. As stated earlier, the Governor has delayed the re-opening of school campuses until August 17th, therefore, we will begin our school year in our Distance Learning model.

Those of you who have signed up for the CJSD Online Learning Academy on our google form (link above) will be receiving an email the week of August 3rd from the supervising teacher explaining all of the details of the program. That week we are also planning on having informational sessions related to our academy, so you can ask questions and get further clarification.
