1) Welcome

Present: LaMonica Claw, Beth Bustya, Lisa Sandoval, Steve Doerksen

2) Hybrid Model Update

Mr. Doerksen gave an update on how the hybrid model was coming along, with ½ of the students attending school each day.

3) Native American Club - Lisa Sandoval

Ms. Sandoval expressed excitement about starting up the Native American club again if the school board chooses to resume the normal school schedule. The club would meet on Thursday's after school.

4) Title VI Update

Mr. Doerksen explained the possibilities of doing more activities with the Native American students, such as: horseback riding, the ropes course in Flagstaff, the museum in Flagstaff, an NAU tour, the alpaca farm tour, Pink Jeep Tour, and Out of Africa. He mentioned how such activities can give students a sense of self-worth and confidence. Ms. Sandoval mentioned the possibility of helping some students with clothing. Ms. Bustya mentioned the Clarkdale train experience. There is funding out of Title VI for these activities. Other suggestions included the YAN ropes course, a walk to Toozigoot and the trail behind Yavapai College. Mr. Doerksen also mentioned that perhaps there could be a summer school program geared particularly towards the Native American population.
