Clarkdale-Jerome Elementary School District is located in the town of Clarkdale, which is located in the Verde Valley of central Arizona. We are a small, K-8th grade school with approximately 450 students. We offer gifted education, ELL instructional support and special needs classes. Students can participate in a wide variety of athletic programs, student council and National Jr. Honor Society.

The District is seeking a full-time special needs teacher to work with our mild to moderately disabled students. Primary caseload includes Preschool through 2nd grade students with Developmental Delays and a couple of middle school students working on Life Skills and Elementary learning standards. Caseload is currently less than 10 students with paraprofessional assistance. Our special needs program has a small student/teacher ratio with an on-site special needs coordinator/teacher to provide support. Disability ranges primarily include Developmental Delay, Other Health Impairment, and Autism. We offer related services onsite, including Speech-Language Therapy and Occupational Therapy. Teachers have access to extensive materials and resources to support learning.
